WALL ATTACHMENT SYSTEM FOR CHESTS, TALLBOYS, & BEDSIDE TABLES

Important Safety Notice

Please retain these instructions for future reference

DID YOU KNOW?

On average a child in the U.S. is involved in a fatal accident every 2 weeks from furniture, appliances or TVs tipping over.

Freestanding chests of drawers/wardrobes can become unstable and may topple if climbed upon and can be especially dangerous to children. Serious injury or death may result. The degree of instability depends on many variables and the purchaser needs to be aware of the potential instability problems and seek to minimize them.

We highly recommend that all chests of drawers are attached to a wall to help prevent this happening. We recommend that a qualified trade's person installs the attachment device supplied to a wall with an appropriate fixing.

We also recommend avoiding actions such as opening multiple drawers at once, allowing children to climb on furniture, putting pressure on open drawers or any action that could cause this chest of drawers to fall forward.

- Secure it! Furniture must be attached securely to the wall. Use the tip over strap provided and the correct hardware for your wall type.
- Place heavy objects in the lowest drawers.
- Never let children climb or hang on drawers, doors, or shelves
- Never put televisions, other heavy objects or items of interest to children on top of chests of drawers or any furniture not intended for use with a television.

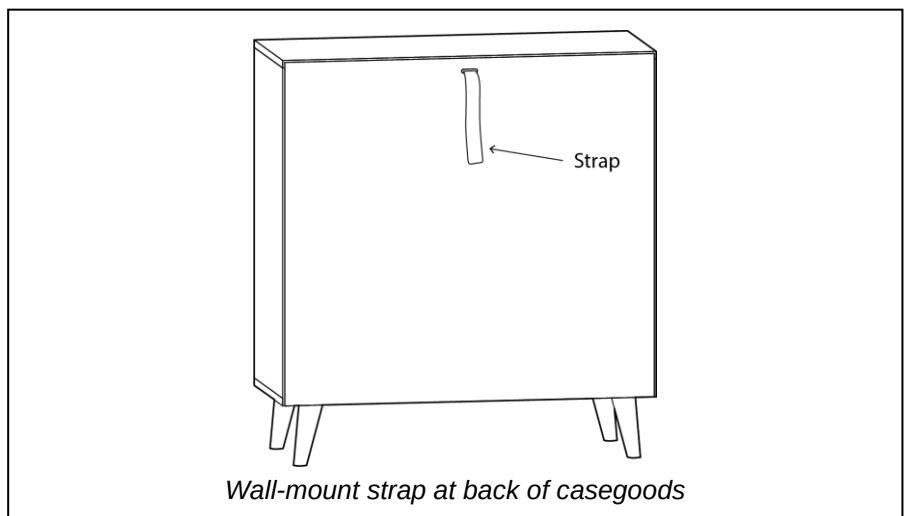

We recommend an appropriately qualified tradesperson carries out the installation. Fixing to a timber stud is preferred over fixing to plaster board. Wall materials and construction vary; appropriate wall fixings can be discussed and purchased from prominent hardware retailers. We do not supply wall fixings			

EQUIPMENT PROVIDED

To fix the casegoods to the wall you have been supplied with – **1x Strap** with a fixing hole at each end (Already secured to the rear of the chest / tallboy / bedside)

TO REMOVE THE STRAP -

The Strap is often tucked inside the casegoods for transport purposes and is not showing from the outside. Removing the top drawer will give access to the strap which can then be passed through the hole in the back of the casegoods. Alternately you can use a long thin item to pull the strap back through the hole in the back of the casegoods.



NOTES

- Button head bolts should be regularly inspected and may need to be retightened periodically
- **Never drag or move assembled bed as this may damage the bed**

CARE & MAINTENANCE

Your SilverLynx product is crafted with care, properly maintained, it will mature over time developing a rich deep patina enhancing its appearance. To get the best performance from your SilverLynx product, please follow the simple care instructions listed below.

- Do not use silicone based polishes/cleaners at any time.
- Dust surfaces gently with a feather duster then wipe gently with a slightly damp cloth/chamois.
- Do not allow liquids, damp clothes to remain in contact with lacquered surface for extended periods.
- Never place furniture in close proximity to heating outlets.
- Exposure to direct sunlight will cause colour fading to fabrics, leathers and timber finishes.
- Do not allow solvents, abrasives or heated objects to come in contact with the suite.
- Do not use cordless drivers or power drills to tighten your bed brackets, as over-tightening can cause the foot end rail to bow.
